



## TREATY

by and between

**Party 1: Autonomous Administration of North and East Syria, Ayn Issa; which derives its laws and principles from the Social Contract, which emphasizes that the Autonomous Administration of North and East Syria is an integral part of Syria. The Social Contract provides equal rights and freedoms for all the people regardless to their ethnic and religious background, ensures women's rights and gender equality, and builds an environmentally sustainable society. The Social Contract was approved by the consensus of the diverse ethnic and religious communities, including Kurds, Arabs, Syriacs, Turkmen, and other communities.**

**Party 2: Transnational Intergovernmental Foundation International Human Rights Commission - IHRC, incorporated in accordance with Swiss legislation, Zurich, Switzerland CHE-388.075.145**

Whereby the signatories shall be referred to as "The Parties", acting on the foundation of their statutes and principles, persuaded into the importance of cooperation on the issues of protection of human rights, enhancing international public security, good governance and administration, based on the agreements attained during the negotiations, would like to agree, write and verify the followings:

### *Article 1*

Under the existing jurisdictions of the Parties, the Parties intend to find the possible ways to develop cooperation on humanitarian policies and exchange of thoughts on issues of common interest at the level pre-approved by the Parties.

### *Article 2*

The Parties are ready to find ways of providing assistance to each other in the area of finding and establishing of working relations with governmental and non-governmental organizations of their countries, other international organizations and representations, municipal and local administrations, law-enforcement and special agencies, ministries, educational and other associations, within the framework of jurisdictions of the Parties. The Parties are obliged to notify each other on issues of cooperation and common interests in accordance with the Articles of this Agreement, taking into consideration the position of the International Human Rights Commission to the United Nations as an organization having received a standing invitation to participate as observer in the session of the General Assembly.

### *Article 3*

The Parties intend to organize informational exchange in order to strengthen the protection of human rights and public safety, with particular emphasis on searching for missing children and the fight against human trafficking, as well as positions of sides in international competition and exporting of "know how", by courtesy of joined international projects, developing and upgrading of international partner-networks. This cooperation will take place on the basis of diplomatic relations, granted all immunities and privileges in accordance with international law on the matter (Vienna Convention of 1975 combined with the Vienna



Convention of 1961 and with the Vienna Convention of 1986) between the Parties established with this Agreement.

*Article 4*

The Parties intend to create a database of relevant experts/consultants to be used by both sides in order to form necessary human and financial resources to participate in joint projects, as well as providing assistance in modern administration developments. The Parties agree to recognize and respect the given diplomatic, military, police, special and public ranks of their servicemen / members, service ID-cards, decorations, as well as to extend to their servicemen / members such assistance and protection as may be necessary and provided.

*Article 5*

To respect the diplomatic relations between the two Parties by giving governmental protection to the officer in charge of the mission according to Vienna Convention of 1961 & 1963 and according to international laws during his term of appointment The Parties will establish a permanent IHRC diplomatic mission in the territory of the Autonomous Administration of Northern and Eastern Syria.

*Article 6*

This Agreement can be updated or reviewed upon the agreement of both Parties. This Agreement can also include additional attachments which should be signed by the representatives of Parties.

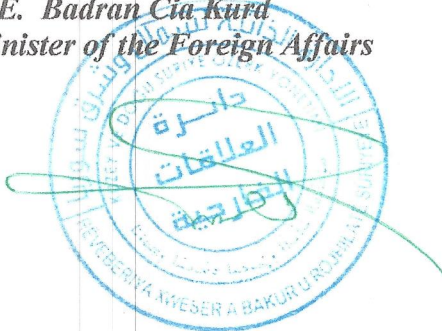
*Article 7*
